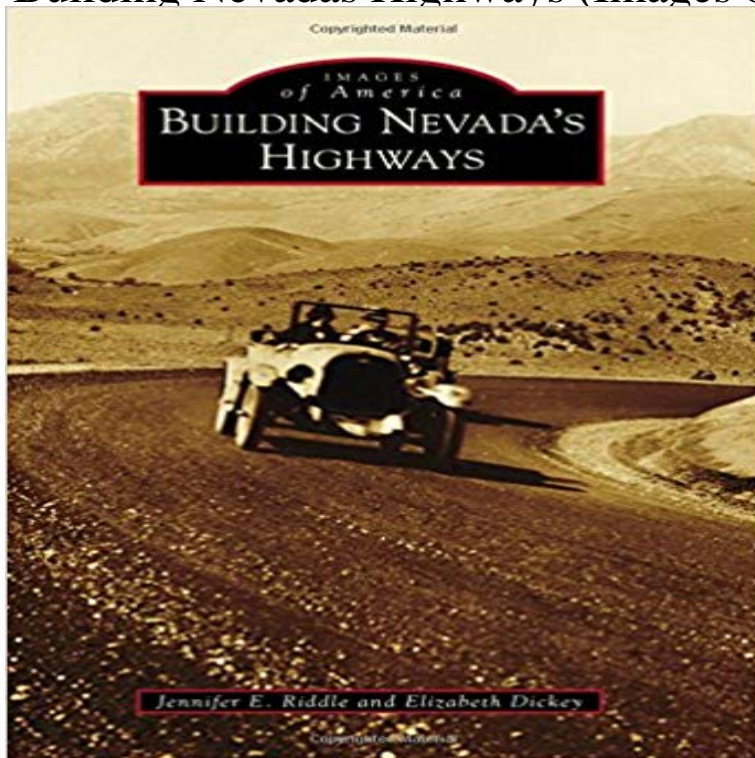


Building Nevadas Highways (Images of America)
