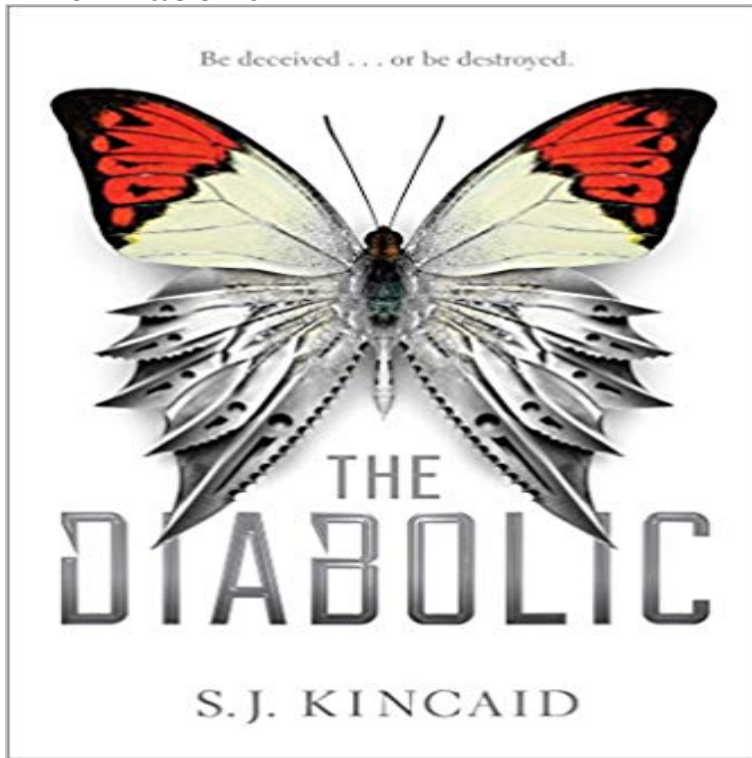


The Diabolic
