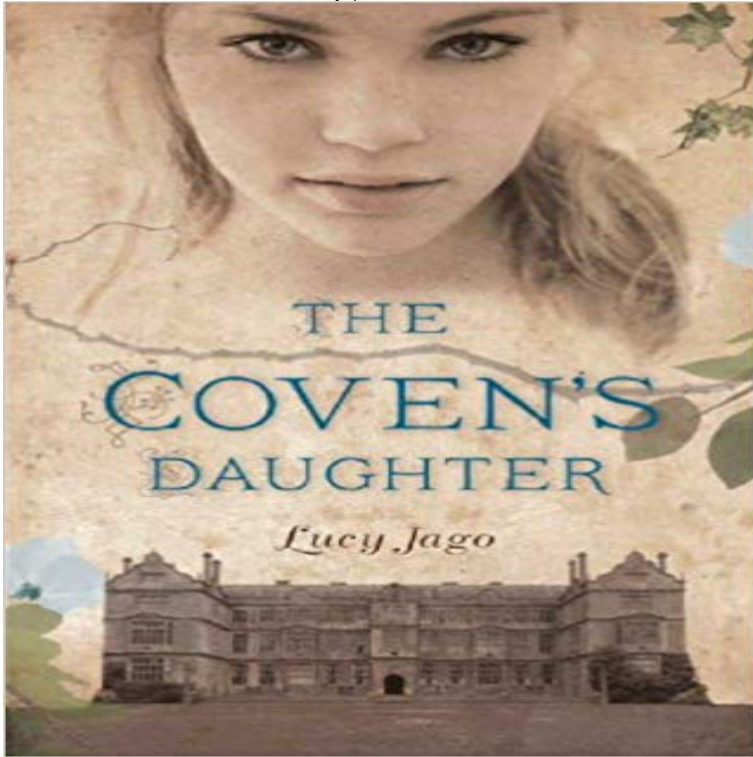


# The Covens Daughter
