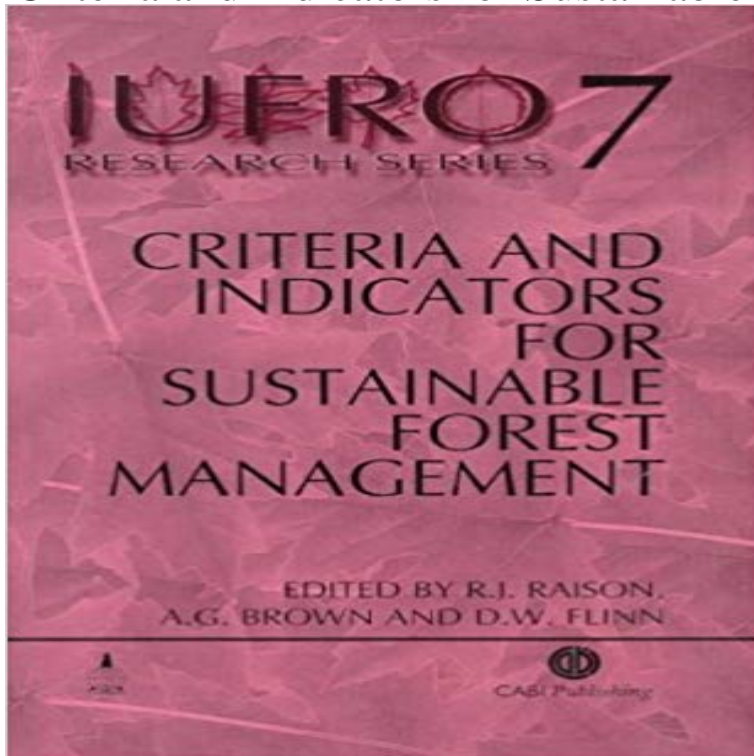


# Criteria and Indicators for Sustainable Forest Management
