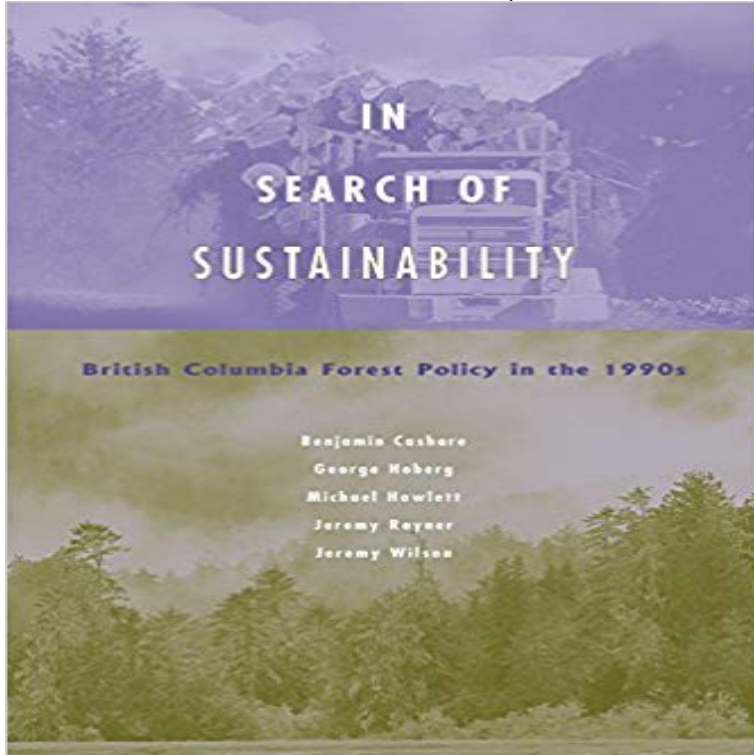


In Search of Sustainability: British Columbia Forest Policy in the 1990s

In an effort to broker peace in the woods, British Columbia's government launched a number of promising new forest policy initiatives in the 1990s. The authors conclude that despite the astonishing level of activism, the government's search for sustainability - whether measured by environmental, social, economic, or political indicators - has ultimately failed.
