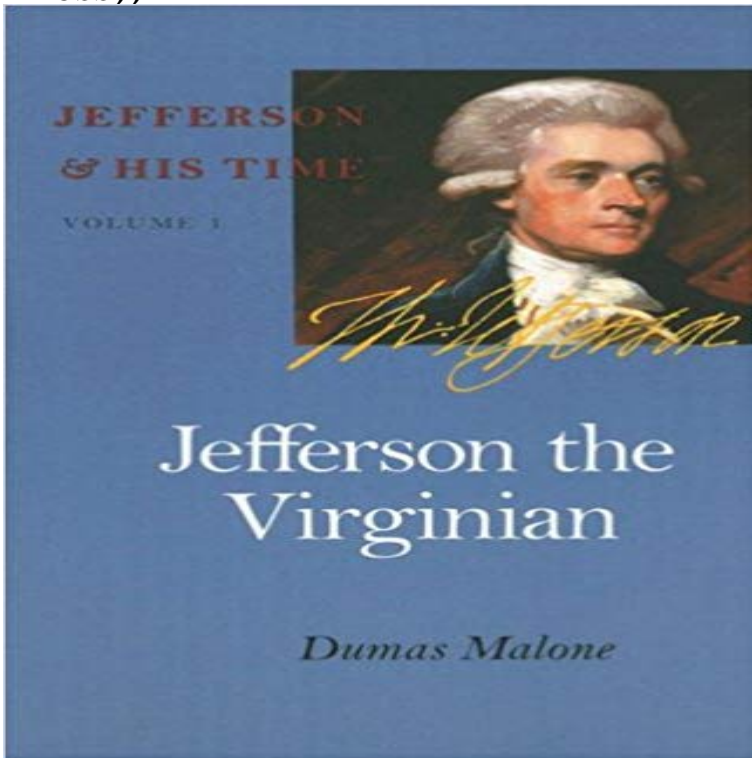


# Jefferson the Virginian (Jefferson & His Time (University of Virginia Press))
