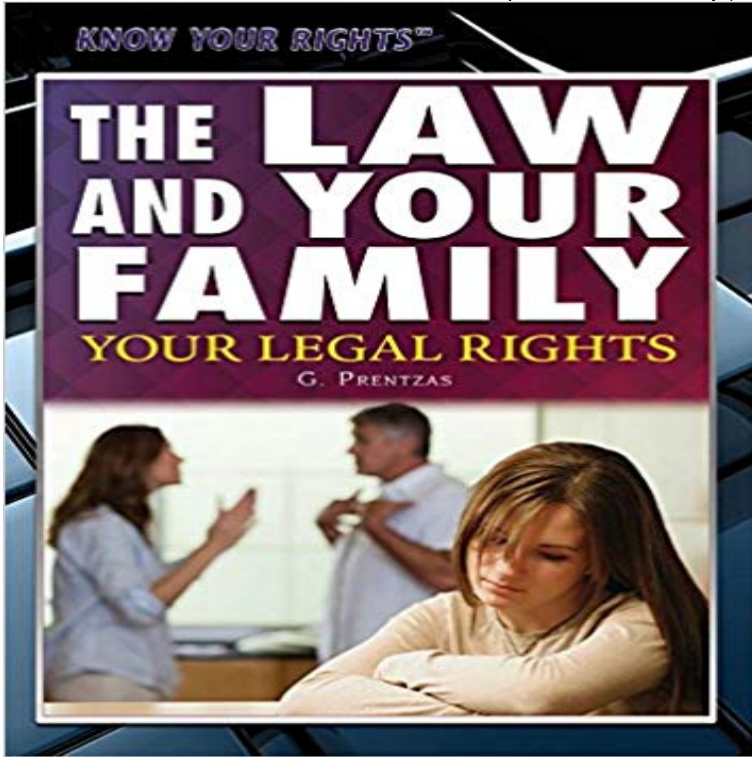


The Law and Your Family: Your Legal Rights (Know Your Rights)
