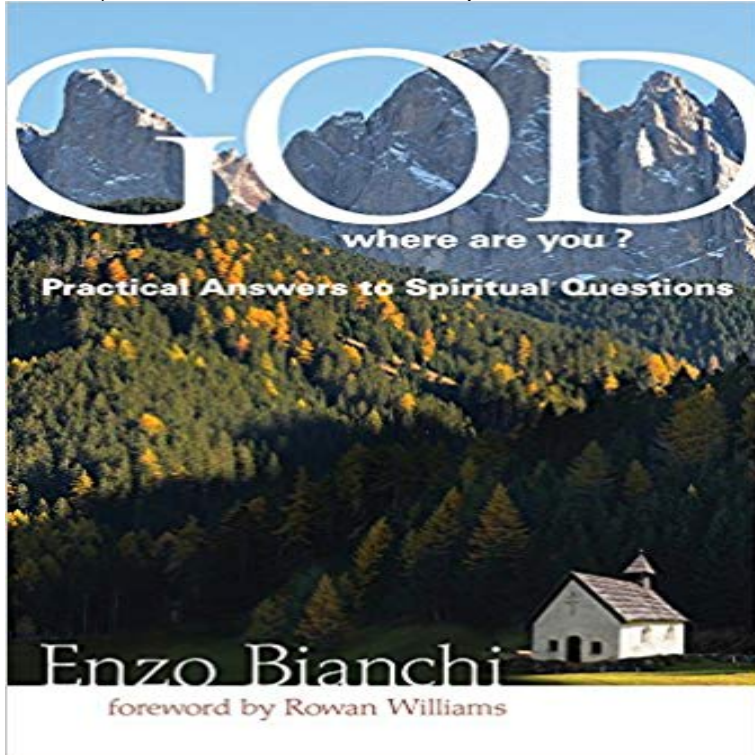


God, Where Are You? (Voices from the Monastery)
