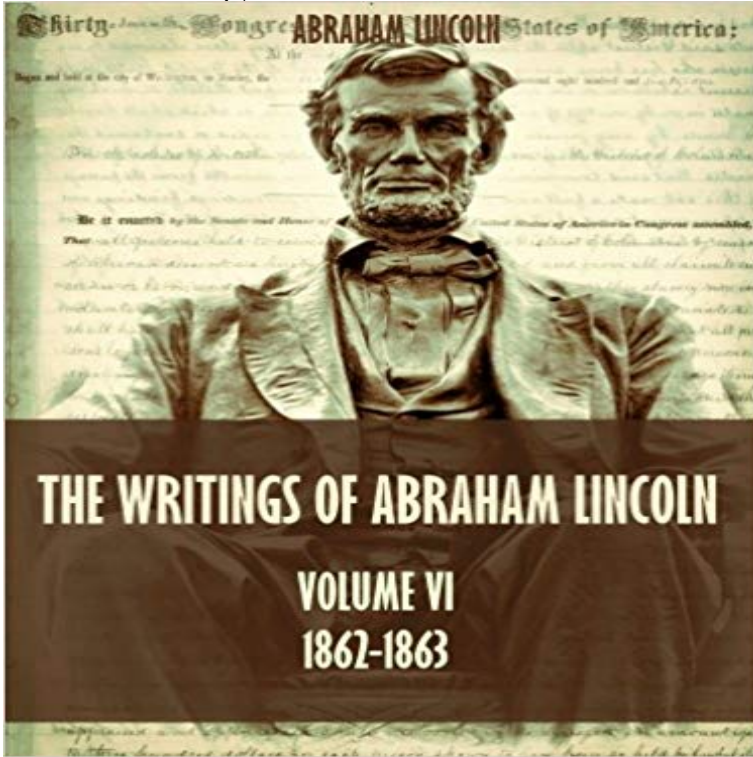


# The Writings of Abraham Lincoln : 1862-1863, Volume VI (Illustrated)
