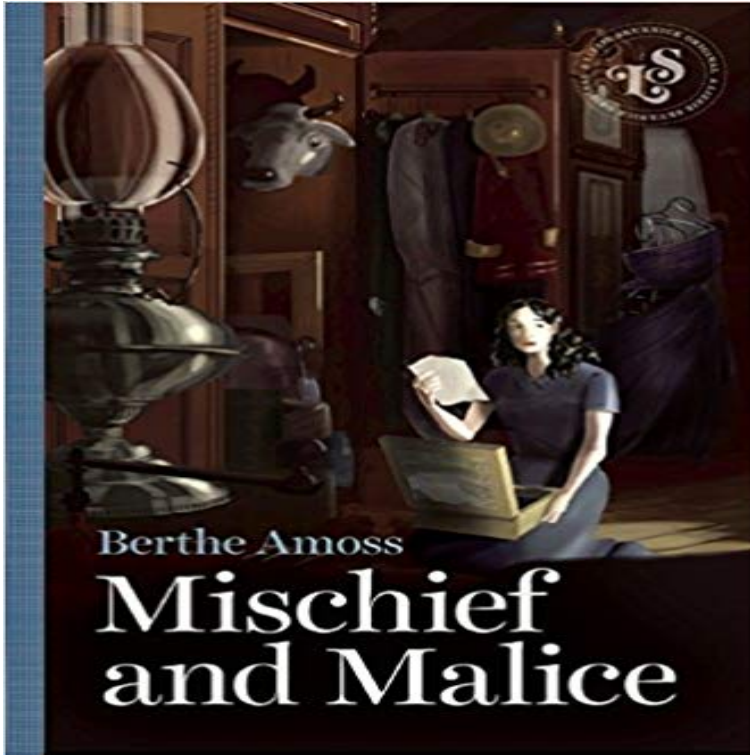


Mischief and Malice
