Between school dances, organizing a Christmas play, fretting about her hair, and a blossoming romance with Tom, Addie stumbles upon a mystery buried in the Great Catch All, an ancient giant armoire filled with heirlooms of her familys past, which holds a devastating secret that could destroy Louis and Toms lives. Once again, Berthe Amoss has created an indelible portrait of a young girl coming of age in prewar New Orleans. Born and raised in New Orleans, Louisiana, Berthe Amoss is the author and illustrator of twenty-eight childrens and young adult books. Her picture book *The Cajun Gingerbread Boy* won a Childrens Choice Award, and her YA novel *The Chalk Cross* was a finalist for the Edgar Allen Poe Award. She lives on the Gulf Coast in Pass Christian, Mississippi.
