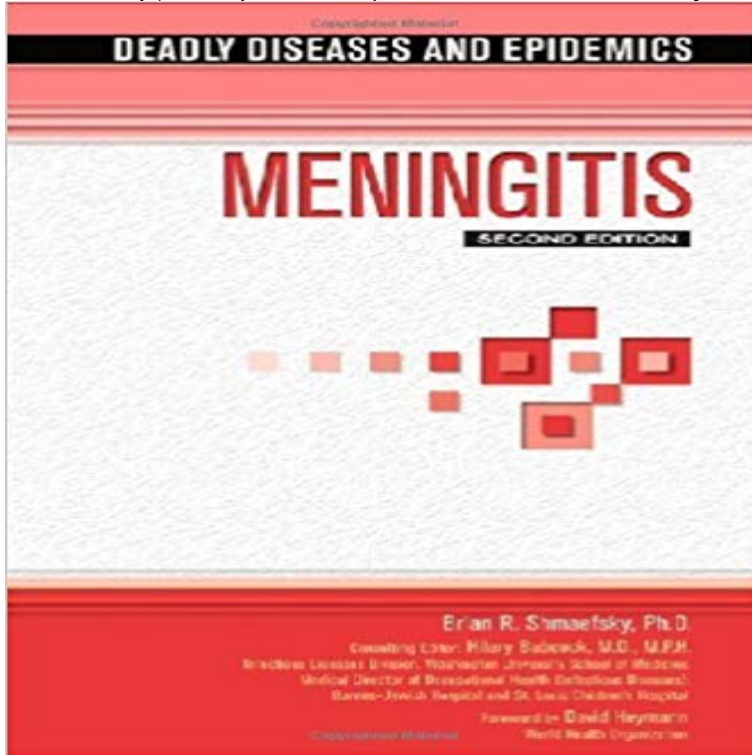


Meningitis (Deadly Diseases and Epidemics)
