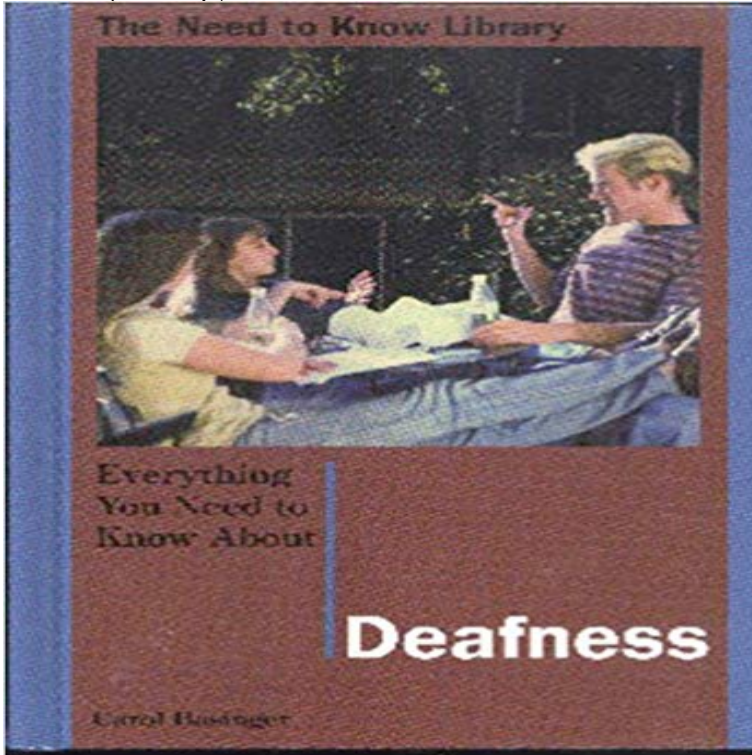


Everything You Need to Know about Deafness (Need to Know Library)
