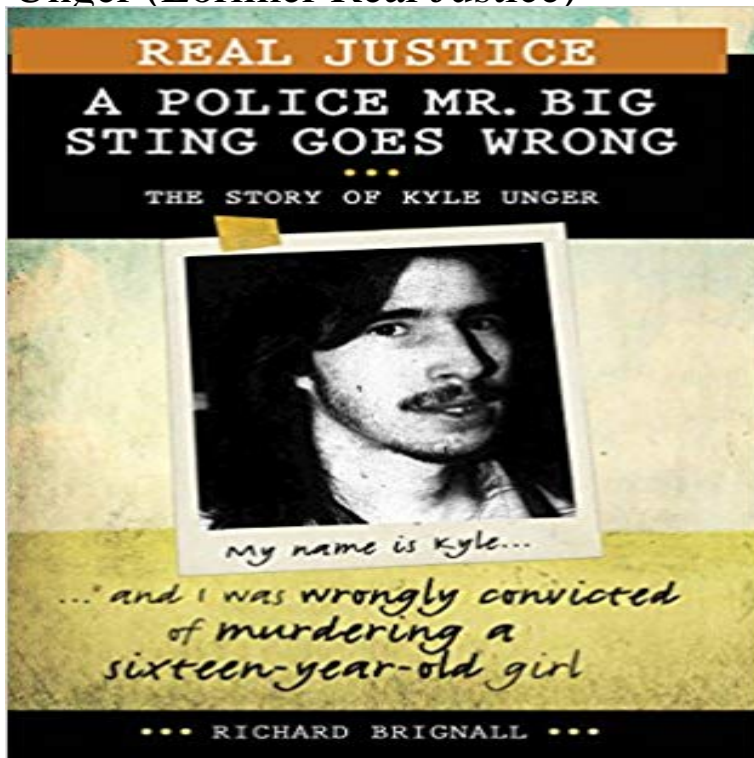


Real Justice: A Police Mr. Big Sting Goes Wrong: The Story of Kyle Unger (Lorimer Real Justice)
