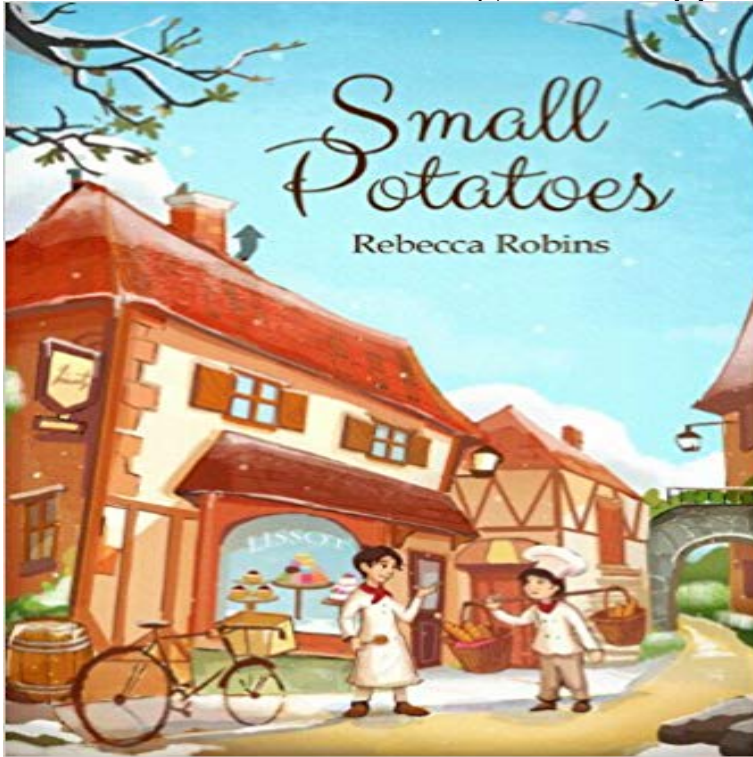


# Small Potatoes: A Young Chefs Apprenticeship in 19th Century Paris
