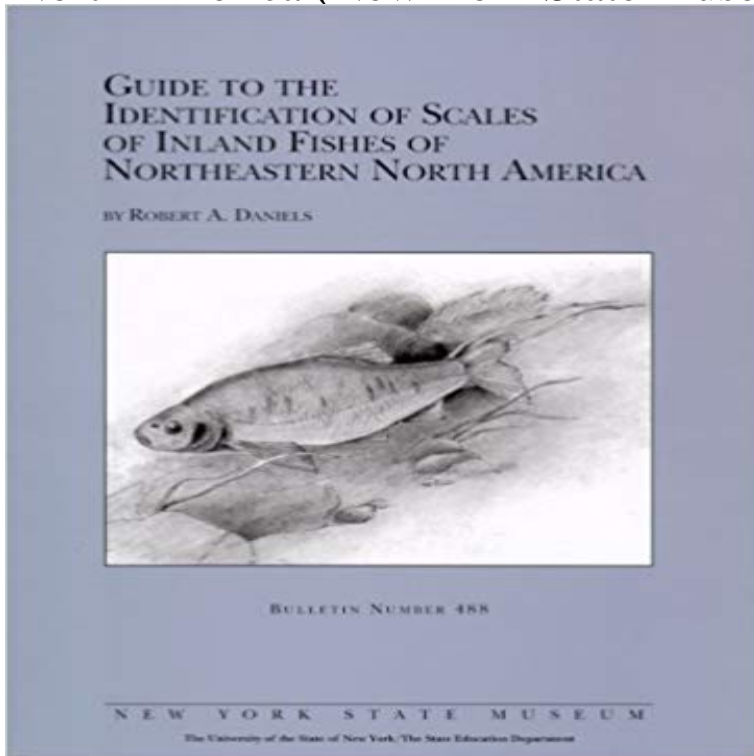


# Guide to the Identification of Scales of the Inland Fishes of Northeastern North America (New York State Museum Bulletin,)
