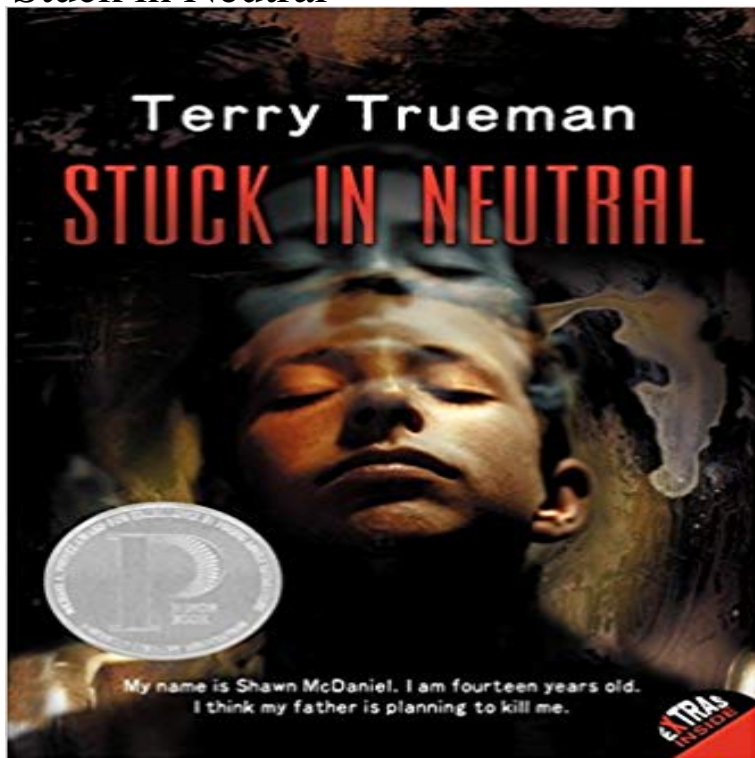


## Stuck in Neutral
