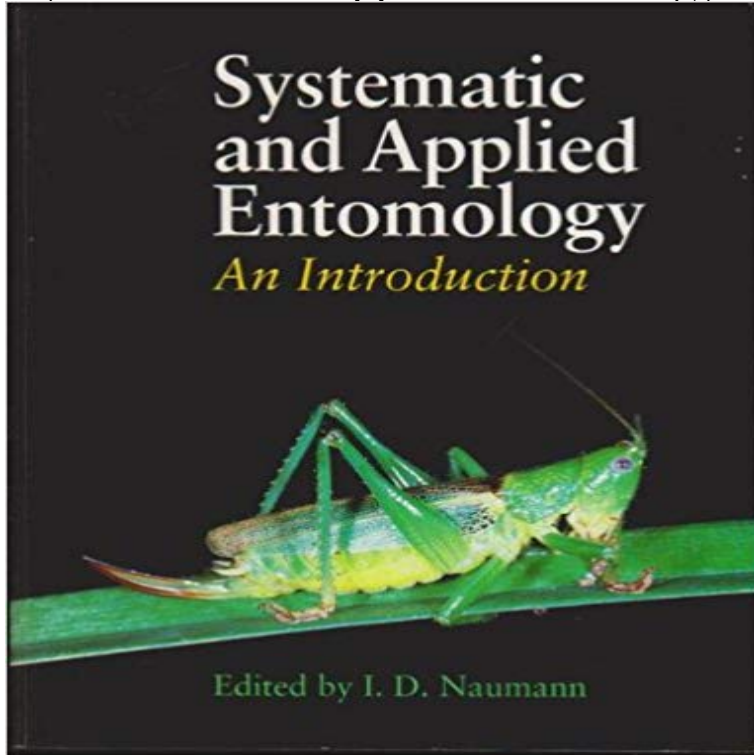


Systematic and Applied Entomology: An Introduction
