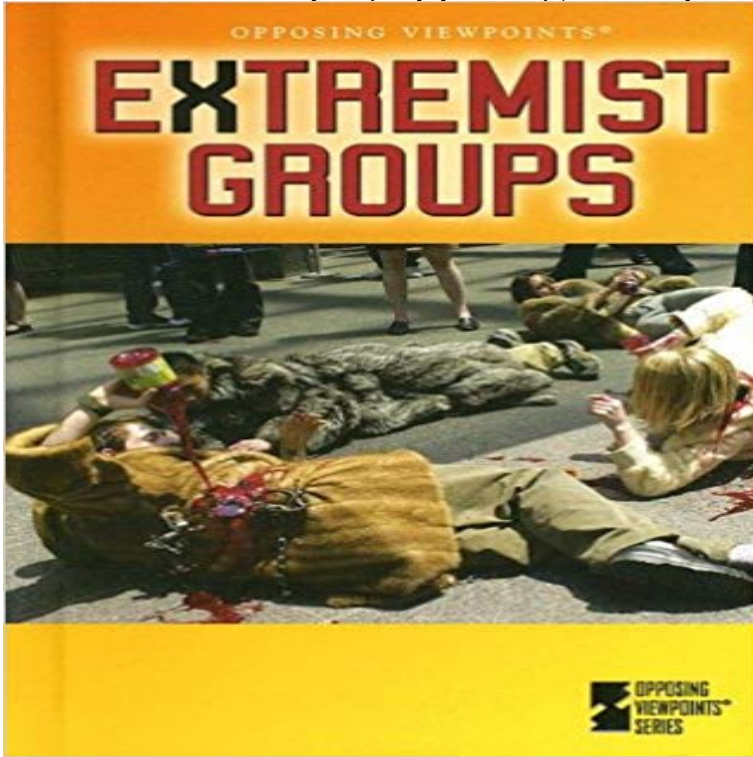


Extremist Groups (Opposing Viewpoints)
