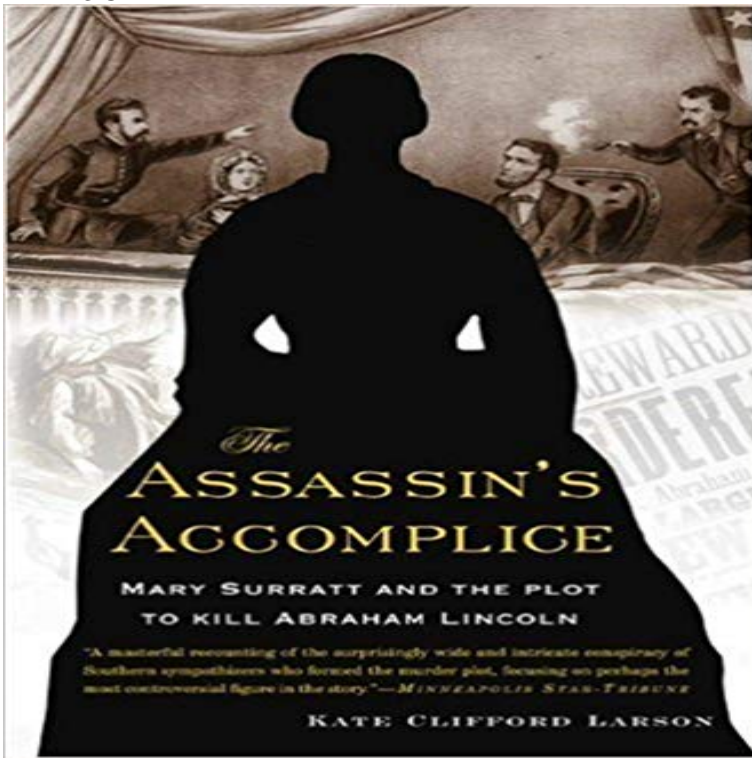


The Assassins Accomplice: Mary Surratt and the Plot to Kill Abraham Lincoln
