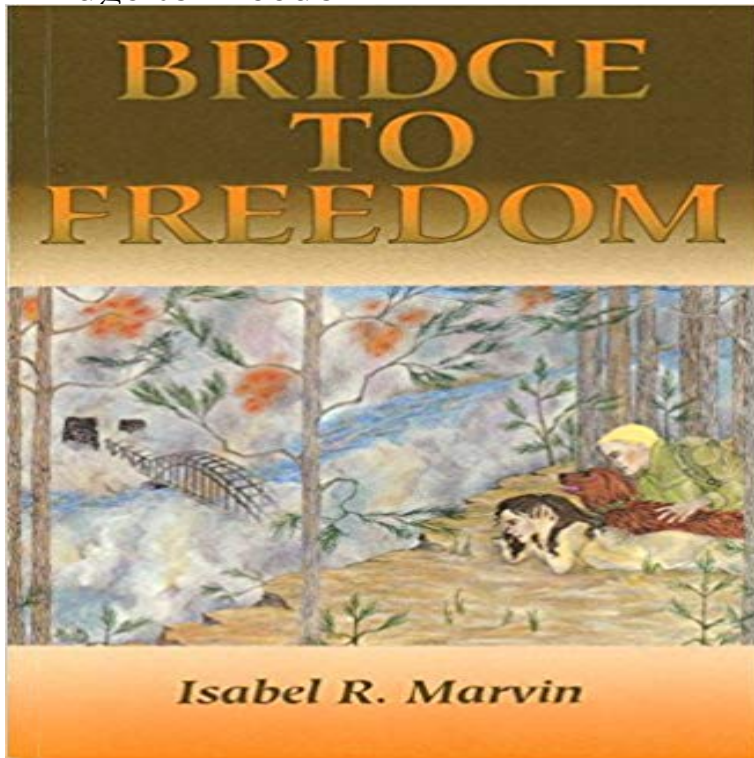


Bridge to Freedom
