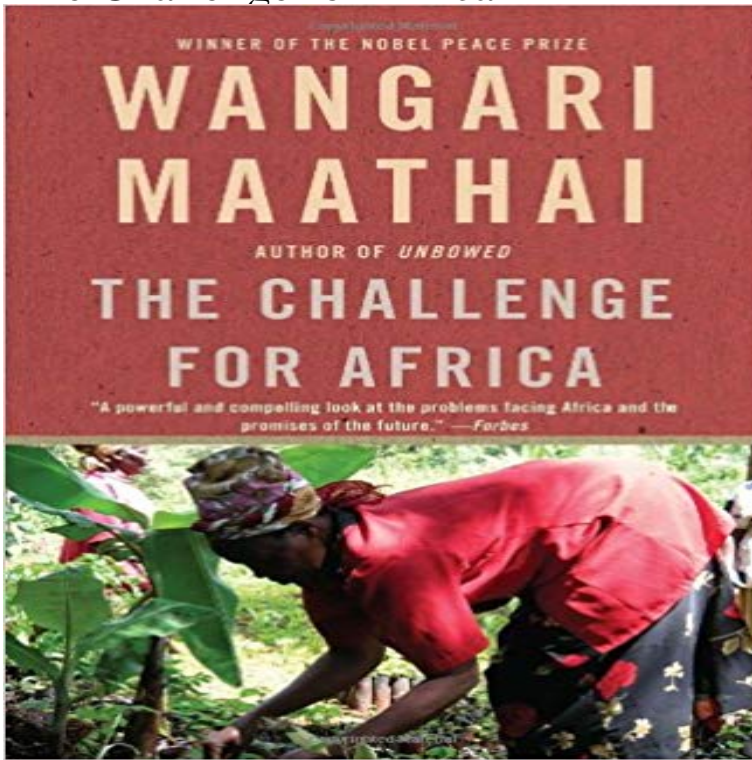


# The Challenge for Africa
