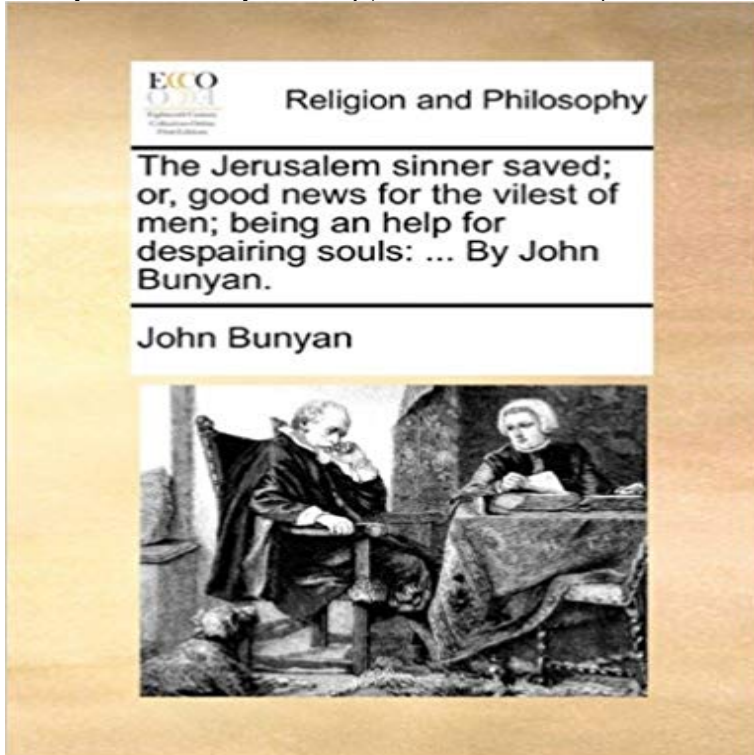


The Jerusalem sinner saved; or, good news for the vilest of men; being an help for despairing souls: ... By John Bunyan.
