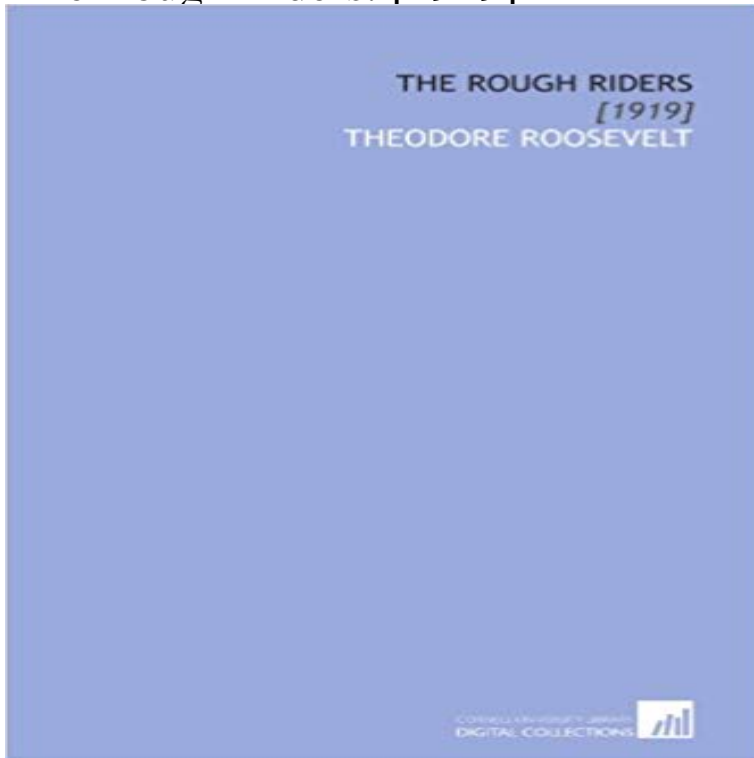


The Rough Riders: [1919]
