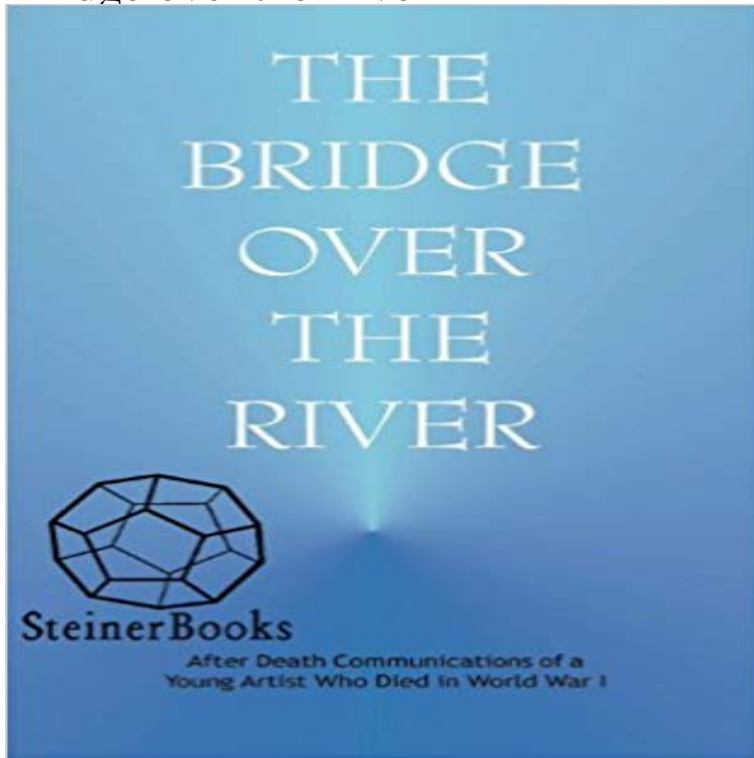


Bridge over the River
