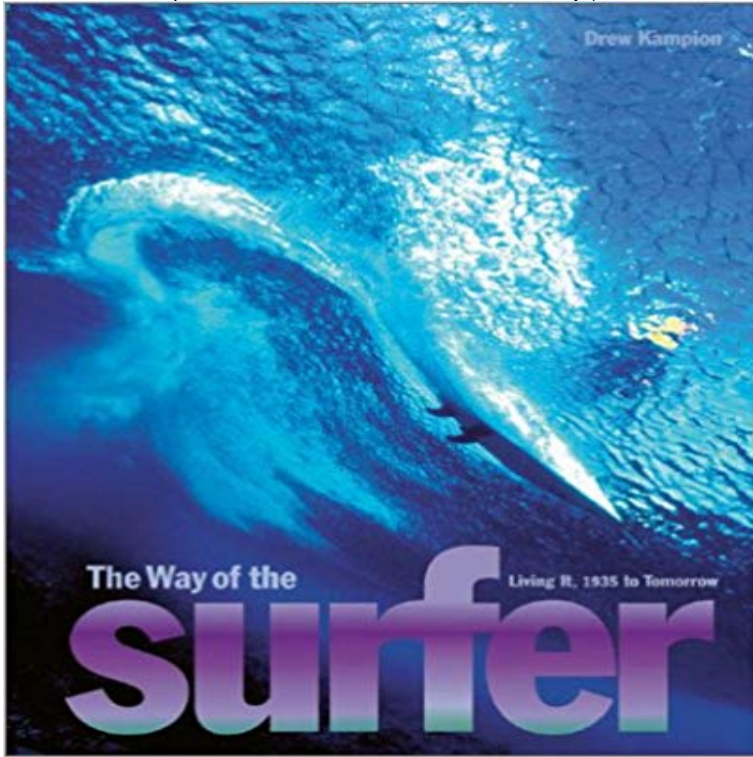


The Way of the Surfer: Living It 1935 to Tomorrow
