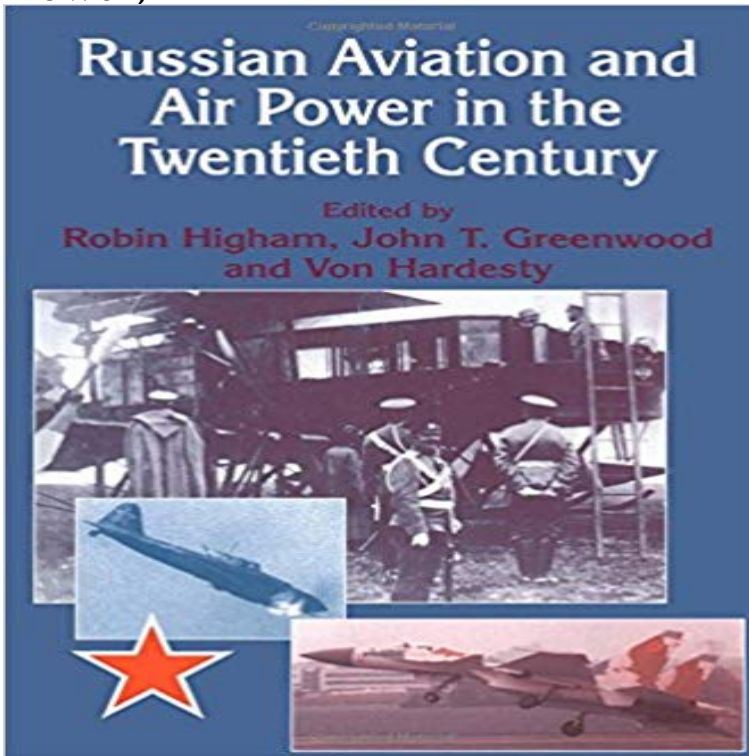


Russian Aviation and Air Power in the Twentieth Century (Studies in Air Power)
