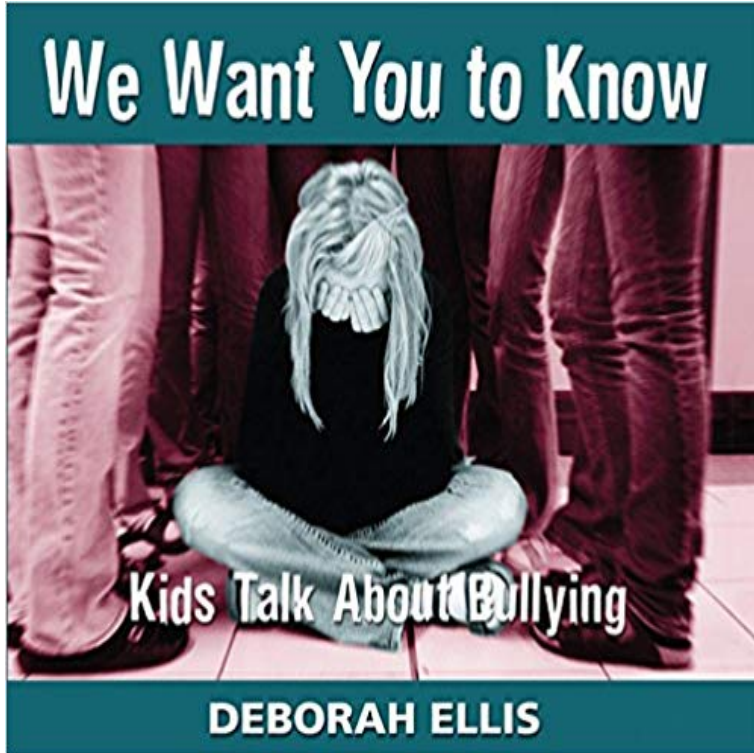


## We Want You to Know: Kids Talk About Bullying

The results are thoughtful, candid, and often harrowing accounts of business as usual in and around today's schools. They talk about which methods have helped and which ones, with the best of intentions, have failed to protect them.
