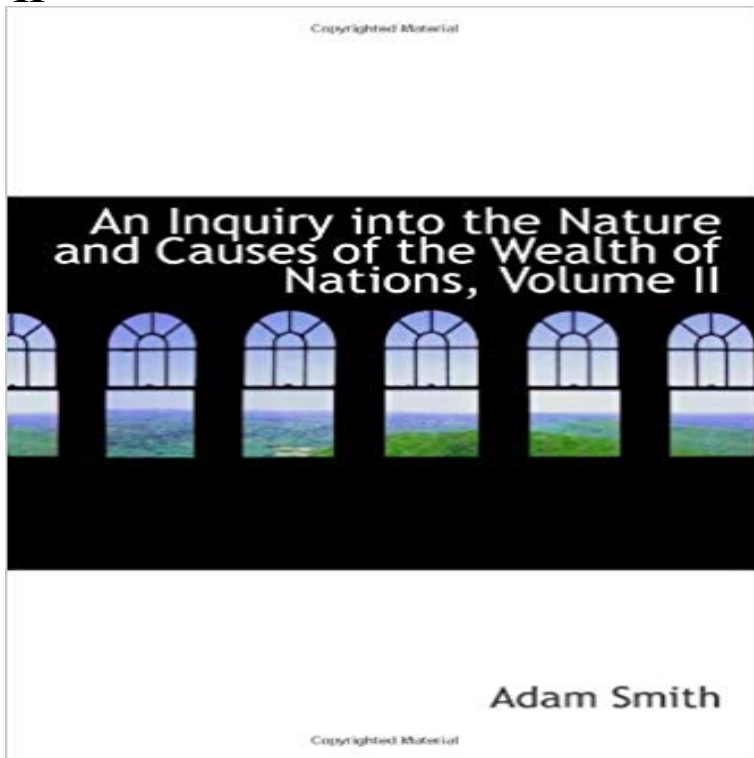


# An Inquiry into the Nature and Causes of the Wealth of Nations, Volume II
