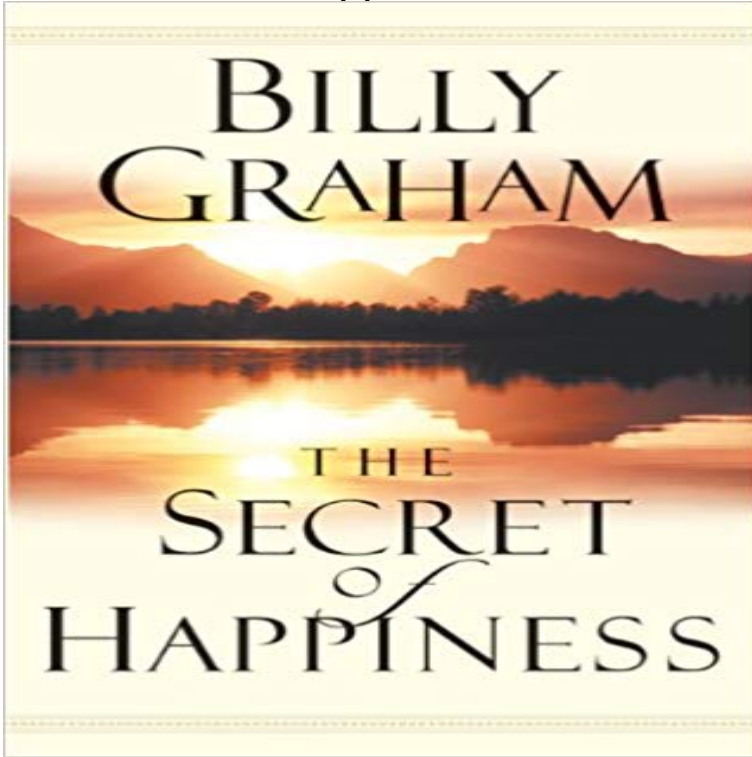


The Secret of Happiness
